ORDER

The Court having held a telephonic status conference on April 6, 2004, and having heard from counsel on the issues raised by the parties, and in light of the competitively sensitive nature of the materials at issue and their vulnerability to unauthorized access, copying, or use for purposes other than this litigation,

IT IS ON THIS 8th day of April, 2004,

ORDERED that Infineon, upon entry of this Order, shall provide to MOSAID's counsel a disk or disks containing the additional discovery materials Infineon made available for inspection on March 31, 2004 (the "Restricted Electronic Outside Counsel Only Materials"); and it is further
(2 copies - 1 for attorney and for 1 expert)

ORDERED that MOSAID's counsel shall not provide access to the Restricted Electronic Outside Counsel Only Materials to anyone other than MOSAID's outside counsel of record and an expert previously approved for access to Infineon confidential information; and it is further


ORDERED that the Restricted Electronic Outside Counsel Only Materials shall be accessed only on a computer that, at the time of such access and at any time Restricted Outside Counsel Only Materials are resident in such computer's memory or otherwise available through such computer, is completely stand-alone and not linked to any network, including without limitation a local area network ("LAN"), an intranet, or the Internet; and it is further

ORDERED that MOSAID's counsel and authorized expert shall make no copy of Restricted Electronic Outside Counsel Only Materials except to the extent loaded into the RAM of the "stand-alone" non-networked computer described above; and it is further

ORDERED that no later than April 13, 2004, MOSAID shall file any motion to ~~compel production of additional materials~~; and it is further

ORDERED that no later than April 20, 2004, Infineon shall respond to any such motion;
and it is further

ORDERED that on April ²⁹ 29, 2004, ^{at 9³⁰} or as soon thereafter as the Court's schedule permits, the Court shall hear oral argument on any motion to compel. (D)
