IT IS ON THIS 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2004

ORDERED that by March 31, 2004, Infineon will identify and produce all "accessible" design review or engineering report type documents, including simulation materials as defined in *Zubulake v. UBS Warburg*, 217 F.R.D. 309 (SDNY 2003); and it is further

ORDERED that by March 31, 2004, Infineon will identify all "inaccessible" design review or engineering report type documents, including simulation materials as defined in *Zubulake* and submit an affidavit regarding the status of "inaccessible" materials; and it is further

ORDERED that by March 31, 2004, MOSAID will review the Infineon design review or engineering report type documents produced to date and identify what has been turned over relating to simulation materials.
