

Dear Mr. Beck:

Pursuant to Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation Rule 7.6(c)(ii), this Court respectfully suggests that the case *Infineon Technologies North America Corp. v. Mosaid Technologies, Inc.*, No. 02-5772 (N.D. Cal.), which was consolidated with another case in this district "for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings,"<sup>1</sup> be remanded to the transferor court for further proceedings. All discovery, fact and expert, has been completed, and the Court recently decided summary judgment motions, greatly narrowing the extant issues to be presented at trial. The only proceedings that remain to be completed are the filing of the pretrial order and motions *in limine*. Because I believe that those proceedings are more efficiently performed in the court where the trial will be held, I believe this case is ready for remand.

In sum, the Court has completed consolidated pretrial proceedings in the *Infineon* action to the extent practicable. There being nothing left for this Court to adjudicate, the Court requests that it be remanded to the transferor court. The parties do not oppose this request.
