ORDER GRANTING IN PART
MOSAID’S MOTION TO SHORTEN
TIME
[re: docket no. 55]

Defendant Mosaid Technologies, Inc. (“Mosaid”) moves to shorten time for hearing on its motion for transfer. Mosaid requests that its motion for transfer, currently scheduled for argument on June 13, 2008, be heard on May 16, 2008. Plaintiff Micron Technology, Inc. (“Micron”) opposes the motion to shorten time, asserting that the May 16 date would unreasonably truncate Micron’s time for briefing and that there is no pressing need to have the motion for transfer heard on shortened time.

The Court will grant Mosaid’s motion to shorten time in part, and will set the motion for transfer on May 30, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. Any opposition shall be filed and served on or before May

1 16, 2008, and any reply shall be filed and served on or before May 23, 2008.¹
