
These matters having been raised by Infineon North America Corp. ("Infineon") in (a) the October 17, 2003, letter, seeking MOSAID Technologies Incorporated ("MOSAID's") validity contentions and MOSAID having responded on October 24, 2003, and (b) in the October 31, 2003 letter, seeking to preclude MOSAID from providing Highly Confidential or Confidential information to Vernon McKenny, MOSAID's expert, and MOSAID having

responded on November 5, 2003; the Court having heard oral argument on these issues on November 6, 2003; and good cause having been shown,

IT IS ON THIS ^{29th} day of December, 2003

ORDERED that both MOSAID and Infineon shall serve no more than 10 single topic interrogatories regarding the new issues not raised in the prior briefings between MOSAID and Samsung, no later than November 10, 2003. Objections and Responses shall be due on November 24, 2003; and it is further

ORDERED that the issue whether MOSAID's retained expert Vern McKenny will have access to Infineon's confidential information will be decided on a formal motion track. Infineon will file its motion seeking an order barring McKenny from access to its confidential information by November 14, 2003, and MOSAID will submit opposition by November 21, 2003. Oral argument shall be held on November 24, 2003 at 10 a.m.
